## Another storm system is approaching

High-elevation areas of **Bergen**, **Passaic and Sussex counties** could get a brief period of snow, sleet or freezing rain *Wednesday* night into early Thursday morning before it all changes to plain rain. the *weather service* says a combination of light snow and a light glaze of ice could make for slippery roads, walkways and parking lots, especially in **areas above 1,000 feet** in elevation.

## **Temperatures Expected to drop**

Daytime highs on *Friday and Saturday* will range from the upper 20s to low 30s in **northern New Jersey** to the mid- to upper 30s in **southern New Jersey**. Morning lows will dip into the teens across the state Saturday and low to mid-20s Sunday.
